

1 Cor 11:27-29 St. Paul

For several weeks now we have been talking about receiving the real body and blood of Jesus Christ in Holy Communion. We listen now to the words of St. Paul to the Corinthians on being prepared to receive the body and blood of Christ. If we haven't been to confession in years as St. Paul indicates or mandates, we must examine ourselves and our sins against the Lord before receiving our Lord in Holy Communion. Recall, Catholicism teaches that after the priest consecrates the bread and wine; it is no longer bread and wine but the true Body and Blood of Christ. How are we preparing to receive Him? Catholics go to Confession or the Sacrament of Reconciliation to be in the graces of God. Read St. Paul's passage to the Corinthians. Where are you? Hopefully we are not bringing judgement upon ourselves.

"Therefore, whoever eats the Bread or drinks the cup of the Lord, unworthily will have to answer for the Body and Blood of The Lord. A person should examine himself, and so eat the bread and drink the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body, eats and drinks judgment on himself."

Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi will be celebrated this year on June 11th. Corpus Christi translated from the Latin means:" **The Body of Christ**." In reality it is the celebration of The Body and Blood of Christ. Archbishop Blair has asked each parish in the Archdiocese of Hartford to have a Eucharistic/Corpus Christi Procession which demonstrates our belief in Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist, after the priest consecrates the bread and wine. The procession will take place on the outside of the Church, in which three Altars will be visited with benediction at each Altar. Solemn Benediction will take place at the main Altar in the Church.

Corpus Christi processions began in Rome in the 1500's with St. Philip Neri processing the Blessed Sacrament through its streets on the Feast of Corpus Christi. Soon this caught the attention of all the countries of Europe. More to follow......

Duties include but are not limited to providing oversight of our modest religious education program for grades 1-10, including sacramental preparation, recruitment of catechists, record keeping, and community outreach to families of the parish.
