

## **Hartford Priest Convocation**

Each year the priests of the Archdiocese of Harford come together in a convocation, to listen, pray and deliberate. This year will be special to us as I am sure our coadjutor Archbishop Christopher Coyne will be joining us. It is also gratifying to learn the status of the Archdiocese in Archbishop Blair's talk. The Priest's convocation will take place on October 2, 3, 4, 2023. Since all priests are required to be present, there will not be a Mass celebrated on those days in the parish Church. Daily Mass will resume on October 5<sup>th</sup> with a regularly scheduled 9 a.m. mass. Please pray for all of us on the Priest's Convocation. Incidentally, since most of the parish churches in the Hartford Archdiocese may not be celebrating daily Mass, I suggest you may want to attend daily mass at St. Luke Church in Ellington, CT (Diocese of Norwich) at 8am.

## **Hartford Bishop's Foundation**

Just an update on the pledges we made to the Harford Bishop's Foundation which also gives money to the parish church for various named projects.
