



St. Damien Joseph De Veuster of Moloka'i


On May 10th the Church celebrates the Feast Day of Saint Damien De Veuster of Moloka'i (Hawaiian Inlands). The two merged parishes in Windsor, CT., St. Gabriel Church and St. Joseph Church in Poquonock are now known as *St. Damien De Veuster Parish*. Incidentally, there is a life size figure of St. Damien De Veuster in St. Gabriel Church. Also, our patron saint, St. Marianne Cope worked very closely with De Veuster, lovingly administering to those with Hansen's disease (lepers).


Born in Tremelo, Belgium on January 3, 1840, he was forced to quit school in order to work on the family farm at the age of 13. In 1860, he entered the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. His brother, Pamphile was a priest in the same Congregation and was chosen to go to Moloka'i to work with the lepers. Because of illness, Fr. Pamphile could not go. Fr. Damien quickly volunteered to take his place.

After setting up places for the lepers to live and eat with his fellow priest missionaries, Fr. Damien chose to stay on permanently in 1873. He administered the leper's physical, medical and spiritual needs. He was very effective in getting government support for the needs of his people. He was very instrumental in getting the Franciscan Sisters of Syracuse, N.Y. to help him, under the direction of St. Marianne Cope.

Pope Benedict XVI (2005-2013) said this of St. Damien De Veuster: "Father Damien made the choice to go to the Island of Moloka'i in the service of Lepers who were there, abandoned by all, exposing himself to the disease which they suffered. With them, he felt at home". Soon, he became a leper. He announced that he had leprosy in 1885.

He was declared "venerable" by Pope St. Paul VI (1963-1978) in 1977; then declared "blessed" by Pope St. John Paul II (1978-2005) in 1995. Pope Benedict XVI (2005-2013) declared him "saint" in 2009.
